

## Where to go for Morning Arrival?



Montebello will open its doors for students at 7:40 A.M. Upon arrival our scholars will :

- ⇒ Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten Scholars will report to the Library (room 102) at 7:40AM and transition to class at 7:45 AM for breakfast
- ⇒ Scholars in grades 1 and 2 will report to their classrooms for breakfast
- ⇒ Scholars in grades 3-5 will enter through the front entrance and they have the option of getting breakfast from cafeteria or report directly to class.
- ⇒ Middle Scholars in grades 6- 8 will enter through the gym entrance and they have the option to get breakfast from the cafeteria or report directly to class.

School starts PROMPTLY at 7:40 AM Late passes are give at 8:00 AM

## It's Dismissal...Where is my child?

Dismissal is promptly at 2:25 PM

- ⇒ Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten will dismiss from the gated grounds at the side entrance.
- ⇒ Scholars in grades 1 and 2 will dismiss out of the side doors and proceed to the black top.
- ⇒ Scholars in grades 3-8 will dismiss from the main front entrance.

If you are interested in donating some of your time to our school, please stop by the main office and fill out an application.



**Note from the Nurse**

Please remember to complete and return the *blue health form* to the school. Our School Nurse needs to be able reach you in the event of an medical emergency.

If your child is taking prescription medicine and needs to have it available during the school day, please make sure you have completed the required medication forms and provide the medication in its original prescription bottle to the Health Suite. (e.g. Asthma Inhaler)

*Did you know the Chronic Health Impairment Program CHIP, provides supplementary instruction for students with chronic illnesses.*

*A medical application must be completed by the doctor yearly, a CHIP teacher will be assigned to your child and you call when services are needed, the CHIP teacher covers the same materials taught in the classroom and the students are marked present when they receive services*
